## Travel Advice for New Guests and Veterans

Over the years CMH has developed a few principles to guide guests through the transition from home to heli-ski lodge. Always:

- Carry your passport.
- Carry-on your ski boots.
- Limit luggage to 18kg/40lbs.
- Advise the CMH Transportation Team of any changes to your travel itinerary.

Upon arriving at Calgary International Airport please collect your luggage and proceed across the street to the Delta Calgary Airport Hotel. There you will be greeted by a CMH representative and given specific instructions.

Late arriving guests or mid-week arrivals should also proceed to the Delta Calgary Airport Hotel where you will be met by a CMH representative or pre-arranged car and

driver to continue your journey into the lodges.

Guests arriving via Kelowna, Prince George, Vancouver or other way-points need to be in contact with the CMH Transportation Team prior to arriving and upon arrival at the airport so that CMH may monitor your progress and travel arrangements.

## Passport Control

**A VALID PASSPORT IS REQUIRED FOR ENTRY INTO CANADA.**

If you arrive in Canada from a foreign country, including the United States of America, you must clear Canadian Customs and will be required to produce a valid passport (in some cases, a driver's license and birth certificate will suffice, however check with authorities before leaving your home).

If you have been convicted of a criminal offence, you may be denied entry into Canada. Contact the Canadian Border Services Agency prior to your departure for more information regarding your official status. You may require a legal pardon from your country or some such docu-

ment to gain entry into Canada.

If you are denied entry into Canada at the port of entry, please notify CMH of your delay and contact your attorney for advice.

## CMH at the Delta Calgary Airport Hotel

Representatives from Canadian Mountain Holidays may be found in the lobby of the Delta Calgary Airport Hotel on Fridays and Saturdays for trips beginning on the weekend; and on certain days during the week to facilitate scheduled mid-week heli-ski trips.

Upon arriving in Calgary, please present yourself to the representatives for a cheerful welcome and specific instructions for continuing on to the lodges.

In the unfortunate circumstance of lost luggage, please file a claim with the airline and repeat the in-

formation to the CMH representative who may monitor the situation and assist with your luggage recovery. CMH will make every effort to forward your luggage to the lodge, however additional expenses may be incurred by the guest and applied to their tripbill.

## Transportation To and From McBride

Transportation to the CMH McBride Lodge is by chartered bus from the Coast Inn of the North Hotel in downtown Prince George to the Town of McBride.

Guests are asked to fly directly to Prince George, BC via Vancouver, BC. Guests should arrive in Prince George on the Friday evening prior to the Saturday start of their CMH McBride trip.

Upon arrival at the Prince George

airport, a shuttle driver will meet guests and shuttle them to the Coast Inn of the North Hotel in downtown Prince George where they will overnight before being driven to CMH McBride Lodge in the morning.

Guests arriving by private plane must check in with the CMH Transportation department prior to landing in Prince George to ensure that the shuttle bus will rendez-

vous with them at the correct time and terminal location.

Driving time from Prince George to McBride is approximately 2.5 hours.

McBride guests leaving the lodge at the end of their heli-skiing holiday will be shuttled back up the Prince George airport where they may make connecting flights to Vancouver or Calgary.

### DIRECTIONS TO NORTH COUNTRY LODGE

**From Banff**, take Hwy. #1 west past **Lake Louise**

to Hwy. #93

**58 KM / 36 miles**

Take Hwy. #93 north to **Jasper**

**223 KM / 138 miles**

Take Hwy. #16 from Jasper, past **Tete Jaune Cache**

to **M<sup>c</sup>Bride**

**163 KM / 101 miles**

There will be a service road on the right hand side of the highway  
at the Husky Station where the **North Country Lodge** is located.

**From Prince George**, take Hwy #16 east to **M<sup>c</sup>Bride** **220 KM / 136 miles**

There will be a service road on the left hand side of the highway  
at the Husky Station where the **North Country Lodge** is located.

CMH McBride is located in the rear of the hotel, it is a separate building.
